

## Jesus Green Association

Committee meeting of 9 January 2013 at 23 Portugal Street: minutes

1. Minutes of 29 October were accepted. There were no matters arising not on the agenda.
2. AB would attend West/Central area committee on 10 January and the meeting on 17 January which would consider funding of projects deemed city-wide in importance, including Jesus Green's Rouse Ball pavilion, drainage and paths.<sup>1</sup>
3. Other regulars: consultation on the children's play area was understood to be on track; RP noted anti-barbecue notices of two sorts variously at 8 of the Green's 9 entry points (the detailed information was transmitted to Sarah Tovell); bench refurbishment as trialled on Christ's Pieces was welcomed; there was no information on tree works, bins and the hammerhead (this last should be urgent if it is to be useful to the next Beer Festival).
4. Minutes of the AGM of 5 December 2012 were approved for recommendation to the next AGM; the number and the concerned interest of those attending was noted with pleasure. PC would pass the minutes to Pippa Noon of the Cam Conservancy.
5. RP reported a balance of £ 132.99 (including 10p interest and a 2p tax deduction). He would seek a Council grant of £100. PC said he could continue lamination of such notices as needed it.
6. DoNM: Monday 18 March at 6.0 p.m., at 9 Park Parade.
7. PC declared his resignation as chairman (he remains a member of committee). He was thanked for his persistence in pressing matters of concern and for much achievement thereby.
8. RP was thanked for his hospitality.
